Contribution rates

The contribution rates for 2022 remain unchanged.

Pension adjustment calculator

The pension adjustment calculators, guides and tables for 2021 will be updated soon. You will find them on our website under the Employer Information menu.

Age 71 employees

For any employees who reach age 71 in 2021, please remember to stop deducting MEPP pension contributions as of November 30.

The *Income Tax Act* (Canada) states that members must start receiving their pension by December 1 of the year they turn 71. For MEPP, this means a member must stop making contributions on November 30 in the year they turn 71. Employment status of a member should not be affected – a member can continue to work for a MEPP employer without contributing to the Plan if the conditions of employment established by the employer allow for it.
