

Stay safe online: why checking links matters

The internet is super important for everything in today's world. When you are surfing the web, you come across a lot of links. Some of these links could be traps set by scammers. These might lead you to fake websites that try to steal your information. Clicking on the wrong link can lead to big trouble such as someone getting hold of your private information or even your money!

Checking your links to make sure they are safe to browse is the best way to make sure scammers never get your information. It is just like checking to see if the door is locked before we step out—a simple step to keep us secure.



Here are **five tricks** to make sure your links are secure:

- 1. Look at the website address (URL). Before you click on a link, take a closer look at the web address. "https://" means your information is protected online, like wearing armour, while "http://" is like sending a letter without a sealed envelope, so it's not as safe. If your website also has a padlock symbol, that means the website has an extra layer of security to make sure it is safer for people to visit.
- 2. Check for spelling and weird characters. Scammers can sometimes create fake

- websites with similar web addresses to trick you. Watch out for misspelled words or strange characters in the URL. If it looks fishy, don't click it!
- 3. Hover over the link. Hover your mouse over the link without clicking on it. A small box should pop up showing the website address the link will take you to. Make sure it matches what you expect.
- **4. Read the description.**Sometimes links come with a description or preview text.

- If it sounds too good to be true or does not match what you are expecting, be careful. It could be a trap.
- 5. Trust your instincts.

 If something feels off or suspicious, it's better to be safe than sorry. Trust yourself and avoid clicking on the link.
